General Comment:Unless the EPA prohibits the use of these poisons (rodenticides) out of doors, the environment will continue to be littered with the dead bodies of rodents that are toxic enough to kill any animals that eat them and will thereby continue passing the poison up the food chain. The use of these poisons in bait boxes outside of buildings and around dumpsters must be prohibited. Killing hawks, owls, and other scavengers and predators is unacceptable for the sake of killing rodents. The effects are too far-reaching. Single feed poisons must not be allowed to be used out-of-doors. If nothing else, this would help prevent potential ingestion of poisons by children and pets.
