Dear sir or madam,

We are writing to you to comment on the potential impact of the regulations proposed in the above notice, especially those pertaining to fire extinguisher requirements.

Should these changes be implemented, carriers such as FedEx and UPS will almost certainly refuse to accept any explosives shipments.

We strongly request that you do not implement these changes as we depend on the ability to receive explosives shipments via these carriers in order to do our work.

The existing requirements under the Department of Transportation/Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration regulations have served the interests of safety well.

Any future changes should be made only after careful consideration of the size of vehicle, type and quantity of cargo, impact on proven, existing practices and the technical merits in improving safety of the proposed change.
