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FOR RENEWAL OF AN EXEMPTION**

Pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 40109(c), United Parcel Service Co. (“UPS”) respectfully files this application for renewal of its exemption authorizing UPS to provide certain scheduled non-stop all-cargo service between Los Angeles, California, and Guadalajara, Mexico. In accordance with Subpart C of the Department’s rules, UPS submits the following information in support of this Application:

1. The Department most recently renewed UPS’s authority to serve the Los Angeles, California - Guadalajara, Mexico route by Notice of Action Taken, issued on November 17, 2005, which provided UPS exemption authority for two years, through November 17, 2007.

2. UPS currently provides the service and has been providing the service since the original grant of the exemption. In lieu of the other information required by the Department’s regulations, UPS relies on the history of its service in the market. The service has been, and remains, consistent with the U.S.-Mexico bilateral air services agreement. The same factors that

warranted the grant of the original exemption remain applicable and warrant the grant of this renewal. All of the facts set forth in UPS's original Application in Docket OST-2000-7282 regarding UPS's citizenship, corporate identity, DOT authority, management and fitness remain accurate today. UPS requests that the authority continue for two years from the Department's final grant of authority requested herein.

3. In accordance with Section 377.10(c) of the Department's rules, this renewal application is timely filed prior to the expiration date of the authority at issue.

4. UPS intends to rely upon the Administrative Procedure Act, specifically, 5 U.S.C. 558(c), which provides that UPS's existing exemption shall not expire until the instant Application has been finally determined by the Department because the existing exemption authorizes "an activity of a continuing nature" within the meaning of that provision.

WHEREFORE, United Parcel Service Co. respectfully requests the Department of Transportation to grant the requested renewal and grant such other relief as it deems just and necessary.
