
1. GRANTEE: Mississippi State and local government officials and persons conducting operations under the direction of those government officials and their designees.
2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATION: This emergency special permit authorizes the transportation in commerce of hazardous materials used to support the recovery and relief efforts to, from and within the Hurricane Katrina disaster areas under conditions that may not meet the Hazardous Materials Regulations. This special permit provides no relief from any regulation other than as specifically stated herein.
3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR, Parts 171 through 180
5. BASIS: This emergency special permit is based on a determination that it is necessary to avoid a risk of significant harm to persons or property in order to facilitate expedited transportation of hazardous materials to, from or within the disaster areas.

6. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (49 CFR § 172.101):

7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES: Compliance with the HMR is required to the extent practicable. When compliance with the HMR is not possible or practicable, shipments may be offered or transported under alternative safety requirements imposed by the grantee.
8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS: Operations under this special permit are limited to the grantee.
9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED: Motor vehicle, rail freight, cargo vessel, cargo aircraft only.
10. MODAL REQUIREMENTS:
- a. The shipper must provide written notification to the carrier of the hazardous materials and packages being offered at the time the shipment is initiated.
 - b. Bulk transportation of hazardous materials by rail freight is not authorized under this special permit.
