

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 21, 2004, the Federal Aviation Administration (hereinafter referred to as "Complainant") filed a Complaint. On December 8, 2004, Peter L. Bradley (hereinafter referred to as "Respondent") had filed a Request for Hearing.

On December 8, 2005, Complainant filed a Motion to Withdraw its Complaint, citing settlement of the matter.

14 C.F.R. § 13.215 states: "At any time before or during a hearing, an agency attorney may withdraw a complaint or party may withdraw a request for a hearing without the consent of the administrative law judge. If an agency attorney withdraws the complaint or a party withdraws the request for a hearing and the answer, the administrative law judge shall dismiss the proceedings under this subpart with prejudice."

WHEREFORE, the within filed Motion for Withdrawal of Complaint, having been read and considered, it is ORDERED as follows:

1. Complainant's request to withdraw its Complaint be and is hereby granted;
2. This proceeding be and is hereby dismissed with prejudice; and
3. Agency counsel shall send to the Judge and the Hearing Docket a copy of any order that the settlement produced.
