**SUPPLEMENTAL CERTIFICATION OF COMAIR, INC.**

On March 24, 2000, Delta Connection carriers Atlantic Coast Jet, Inc., Atlantic Southeast Airlines, Inc., and Comair, Inc. ("Comair"), applied for exemptions from Subparts K and S of 14 C.F.R. Part 93 pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 41716 for regional jet services to and from LaGuardia Airport. By Order 2000-4-11, issued April 14, 2000, the Department granted blanket approval for such slot exemptions, subject to the applicant carriers filing certifications in accordance with that Order.

In response to the Department's Order, Comair has submitted previous certifications with respect to service between LaGuardia and certain cities. Comair hereby supplements that certification to cover service with seven (7) additional LaGuardia slot exemptions. Effective January 31, 2002, Comair plans to operate two nonstop round-trips between LaGuardia and Birmingham, replacing existing service currently provided by Atlantic Coast Airlines. The ACA service will be discontinued on the same date. Effective February 15, 2002, Comair plans to operate two nonstop

southbound flights from LaGuardia to Savannah, and one northbound nonstop flight on the same route, replacing existing service currently provided by ACA. The ACA service will be discontinued on the same date. Comair's supplemental certification with respect to the slot exemptions for this service is set forth in Attachment 1 hereto. Additional information regarding this service is contained in Attachments 2 and 3 hereto. Both Birmingham Municipal Airport and Savannah International Airport are small hub airports in compliance with 49 U.S.C. § 41716. The slot times needed to provide the additional LaGuardia flights are listed in Attachment 3 hereto (one of the arriving flights will use a regular slot, not an AIR 21 slot exemption).


## ATTACHMENT 1

### SUPPLEMENTAL CERTIFICATION OF COMAIR, INC.

I, Donald T. Bornhorst, Senior Vice President - Customers of Comair, Inc. ("Comair"), hereby certify, in accordance with 14 C.F.R. § 302.4(b), that Comair meets each and every one of the statutory criteria set forth in 49 U.S.C. § 41716 for slot exemptions for regional jet services to and from LaGuardia Airport. More specifically, I hereby certify that:

1. The communities and airports that Comair intends to serve are listed in Attachment 2.
2. Comair was not providing nonstop service between the communities listed in Attachment 2 and LaGuardia Airport during the week of November 1, 1999.
3. The aircraft that Comair will use for such services have fewer than 71 seats.
4. The aircraft that Comair will use for such services are Stage 3 compliant.
5. The planned effective date for the service is set forth in Attachment 2.

Furthermore, I hereby certify that, pursuant to Title 18 United States Code Section 1001, I, in my individual capacity and as the authorized representative of the pleader, have not in any manner knowingly and willfully falsified, concealed or failed to disclose any material fact or made any false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or knowingly used any documents which contain such statements in connection with the preparation, filing or prosecution of the pleading. I understand that an individual who is found to have violated the provisions of 18 U.S.C. section 1001 shall be fined or imprisoned not more than five years, or both.
