

It is imperative that your department not only review N.T.P.R.M., expanding international air service, docket #46534, but write it into law starting immediately.

The Niagara Frontier area of New York State is located in a gateway corridor to Canada. The recently adopted free trade agreement with that country plus the ideal location, affords this area a much needed opportunity to regain the prestige lost during the recession years of the 1970s.

The Niagara Falls International Airport has the availability of runway and service facilities capable of handling the largest jet aircraft manufactured today. The airport is a much hidden secret just waiting to be discovered.

Passage of N.T.P.R.M. docket #46534 will give the airport and the area the required notoriety for success.
