I am concerned that the **Hazardous Materials Transportation; Registration and Fee Assessment Program (PHMSA Docket No. PHMSA-2006-25589 [HM-208F])** will burden my company with additional costs without having any real impact on safety for handlers or customers.

We have developed an excellent safety-related Web site, [www.propanesafety.com](http://www.propanesafety.com). It would be unfortunate for our industry and for Ferrellgas to see these efforts ignored in favor of higher fees.

I urge you to re-examine the programs and fees that are already in place and to recognize that companies like Ferrellgas are constantly on the forefront of improving safety practices. To burden these leaders with millions of dollars in additional cost would serve only to hinder additional progress.
