

I have a "single engine land" private pilot's certificate, and live in the York, Pa area. Since the ADIZ has been established, given the many problems other pilots have had, I'm really intimidated by its entry requirements, so I don't head south so as to avoid potential problems. I understand what the process is, but I frankly don't want to make a mistake that would have the potential of suspending my certificate, not to speak of an attack aircraft or helicopter on my tail. Protecting the nation's capitol is very important, but is the present size of the ADIZ necessary for its protection? Given that there is no history or realistic potential of a small aircraft being a terrorist threat, I don't believe that the same restrictions should exist for light aircraft.
