

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

By this order Respondent is ordered to show cause by April 30, 2004, receipt date in Washington DC, why a default order assessing civil penalty of \$43,750 should not be assessed against it without a hearing. Respondent currently is in default, having failed to file an answer to the FAA's complaint [see 14 CFR 13.201 et. seq.]. Absent an answer, the allegations in the complaint are to taken as admitted, obviating the need for a hearing. Moreover, no answer has been received to the FAA's Motion to Deem Allegations Admitted, filed on March 9, 2004. Any response to this order shall be filed by facsimile or by express carrier, as the Postal Service is delaying mail to this zip code. After April 30, 2004, a final order assessing civil penalty will issue in the absence of good cause shown.
