On August 13, 2004 Innophos Inc. was granted party status to DOT E-13796, an exemption that authorized the shipment of Yellow Phosphorus in alternate packaging. The emergency exemption expires on Nov. 30, 2004. This letter serves as our request to convert this emergency exemption to a standard exemption (ie: extend to 2 years) in accordance with the requirements listed in 49CFR 107.109.
