

I wish to comment in reference to docket number FAA-2001-11229.

In my opinion, the flight crew of an airliner should be allowed to be armed provided they have passed the equivalent of many states concealed carry requirements.

At the very least, a weapon should be available in the cockpit as part of the emergency supplies so the flight crew can use it if needed.

Since these people already have control of the plane, access to a weapon would seem to be a minor risk contrary to what some people may claim who are more concerned with eliminating firearms than with logic.
