Dear National Highway Traffic Safety Administration,

I am writing to you regarding DOT Docket (NHTSA 02-11419). I urge you to dramatically increase the proposed fuel economy standards for light trucks and SUVs.

As you know, fuel economy standards for light trucks and SUVs have remained at a mere 20.7 miles per gallon (mpg) since 1996. The Bush administration has finally proposed an increase, but it is extremely disappointing: a mere 1.5 mpg. Even worse, the auto industry has been given until 2007 to meet this paltry goal.

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Therefore, I urge you to propose tougher rules to raise fuel economy standards to more than 40 mpg for all passenger vehicles, including pick-up trucks and sport utility vehicles. Please tell me how you intend to address this important issue.
