I am submitting comments regarding DOT Docket #NHTSA 02-11419.

Your proposal to increase fuel economy standards for SUVs and other light trucks by only 1.5 miles per gallon by 2007 is woefully inadequate. This proposal would save just a tiny fraction of the oil we import from the Middle East. In fact, the proposal would not even make up the ground lost since passenger vehicle fuel economy levels peaked fifteen years ago, and is no more ambitious than the voluntary plans automakers have already announced.

I and other Americans have a right to expect much more. Studies show that technology is currently available to increase fleet-wide fuel economy to over 40 miles per gallon while enhancing vehicle safety. You have the authority, and the responsibility, to reduce our dangerous dependence on foreign oil, protect the environment, and save consumers money by requiring such an increase in automobile fuel economy. I urge you to use this authority, and to strengthen the proposed increase.
