Please find the enclosed copy of your *Health Inspection for 2002* for the **Douglas Pond**. No prohibited pathogens were detected during the inspection. Fish Health approval for this site is dependent on two years of a clean inspection history, this inspection is the first years inspection.

Due to the low numbers of fish in this facility and given your concern about sacrificing 60 more of the fingerlings, we have discussed applying for a variance to move fish from the pond prior to gaining fish health approval. I am in support of your request, and will be glad to supply the needed documentation in regards to the health of these fish. The next FHPB meeting is April 11, 2003 in Salt Lake City. We should get together before this time and discuss the presentation details.
