Subject Deny reduction of RFS

EPA: regarding comment period for RFS waiver.

With 60+% of US fuel coming from foreign sources EPA should NOT grant a waiver from the goals of the RFS as requested by Gov. Perry. Texas A & M Study did not show any significant relationship to food costs and ethanol production. 1/3 of corn kernel is returned to the livestock industry as a high protein feed.

Without the existing ethanol industry consumers would 15% more for fuel. Plus, refineries are already running at capacity.

Providing a waiver to the RFS would not bring food prices down with \$135/barrel crude. Diesel prices are impacting consumers far more than ethanol production.
