Mr. Laney:
Please find the response below to the questions and/or clarifications regarding the Louisville facility.

1. *The amount of CKD recycled to process (65,559) is more than the CKD generated (22,550). Should these numbers be switched?*

The data was incorrectly transcribed into the table. The correct data is shown below.

Kiln	2006 Cement Kiln Dust (CKD)		CKD removed and landfilled on-site [tons per year]

Kiln 1 (ACL)	22,550	22,250	0
Kiln 2 (HW)	65,559	65,559	0

2. *Confirm that the amount of CKD removed from the process (i.e., not returned to the kiln) is 0 tpy.*

All CKD was returned to the kilns, none was removed from the process.

3. *The Hg and TOC analyses for CKD – What are the designations “ACL” and “HW”? If “HW” is hazardous waste, there is no information on the annual amount of hazardous waste fed to the kiln.*

Kiln number 1 is a Leopold design manufactured by Allis-Chalmers. The routine designation is “ACL.”

Kiln number 2 was manufactured by Humboldt-Wedag. It is routinely designated as “HW.”
No hazardous waste is burned on either kiln.
